Job Summary:

Resident teaching artists are responsible for planning and delivery of a wide variety of theatre education programming for students of all ages. Our education programs include diverse offerings for senior citizens, homeschool groups, students with special needs, and resident performance companies at Stage Door Theatre. The Resident Teaching Artist (with the support of the Education Department) is responsible for:

Responsibilities:

- Guiding participants of many ages and backgrounds through theatre activities, games, and exercises that foster growth.
- In some cases, teaching artists are asked to design or adapt a curriculum that aligns with organizational learning objectives to using their unique skills and experience.
- Creating a safe and inclusive classroom environment where every student feels valued. Fostering a sense of belonging and connection among students, promoting teamwork and respect.
- Addressing individual needs and adapting teaching methods to accommodate diverse learners.
- Maintaining open communication with students, parents, and colleagues to address concerns and share progress.
- Exhibiting professionalism, punctuality, and a positive attitude in all interactions
- Adhering to child protection policies and procedures to ensure the safety and well-being of students

Qualifications:

- Experience as a teaching artist
- Experience in theatre
- Bilingual preferred
- Experience with elderly, special needs, or other specific populations preferred
- A flexible schedule that allows for a variable class hours around the North Metro area.

Selection Process:

- Candidates will be asked to construct a lesson plan for a sample class.

- Candidates will be asked to attend 1-2 interviews with Education Director and one other member of SDT staff
